I can think of few communities that are more difficult to unite and motivate than academics. The egos! The opinions! The demands of teaching! The demands of scholarship! It takes a person of rare gifts to bring them out of their offices, unite them, and inspire them.

She moderated panel discussions with expertise, efficiency, and grace. What's more, she has emceed Q-and-A sessions with cleverness and creativity, which can be a challenge in communities of academics prone to speechifying.

And through it all, Dr. Copeland always responds to anyone who approaches her with a radiant spirit of welcome, delight, and humor.
